- Produce plans that show how we each will achieve net-zero emissions by 2050, individually and working with others.
- Use our influence to advocate for policy that supports an economy-wide transition to #ZeroCarbon2050.
- This includes encouraging national government to increase their climate ambition through a strengthened Nationally Determined Contribution and setting long-term strategies to reach net-zero emissions by 2050.

A Special Report of the scientific body, the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, tells us that it is still possible to limit global warming to 1.5°C. But only if we act over the next ten years to reach net-zero emissions globally by mid-century.

It is going to take concerted action by all of us. We are showing that it can be done!
